Dear Friends.





Austin: Catholic Charities Awarded \$1.9 Million for Project Connect. Catholic Charities was one of 14 area nonprofits chosen by the City of Austin to spearhead Project Connect anti-displacement efforts. With the \$1.9 million awarded to our organization, Catholic Charities will help people who are vulnerable to displacement through financial aid, long-term case management, financial literacy education, and wraparound services.

Brazos Valley: Keeping Kids Warm this Winter.

Catholic Charities partnered with Knights of Columbus Council 3205 to help children in need stay warm over the winter. In November, our Brazos Valley office staff distributed 145 free coats at our annual Coats for Kids event.
